



Using the Chatterbox

Spark conversations with this chatterbox designed as a playful, nostalgic tool. Each flap contains ageist phrases you may have heard, alongside prompt questions to get people talking.

- 1 Ask someone to pick a word that's written on one of the square pockets.
- 2 Open and close the chatterbox by spelling out the word.
- 3 Ask them to choose one of the numbers written inside, then open and close the chatterbox by counting out the chosen number.
- 4 Ask them to choose another number. Open it and read the question.

Making a Chatterbox

- 1 Cut out the square template.
- 2 Fold the square sheet in half to make a rectangle.
- 3 Fold the rectangle in half to make a smaller square.
- 4 Unfold it all and lay it so the blank side is face up.
- 5 Fold each corner into the centre.
- 6 Turn the sheet over and fold each corner into the centre.
- 7 Fold this new square in half.
- 8 Slip your fingers under the paper tongues and pinch or pull - the chatterbox will begin to take shape as you do.
